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New Year's Resolution: Save Money While Help Saving The Planet

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When we save energy, we save money, but more importantly we save on the use of fossil fuels such as coal, natural gas and oil. Low Flow Shower Heads (Average Cost \$10 to \$20) can save 300 lbs. of CO₂ for electric heated and 80 lbs for gas heated water.

Clean A/C Filters Your a/c units and heaters to work less, again saving money and reducing the CO₂ emissions by approximately 175 lbs per year.

This may not sound like much but if you consider the average American produces around 40,000 pounds of CO₂ emissions per year, even a small change will have an impact.

These are just three of many simple ways to conserve and insure we not only have energy supplies and a cleaner safer environment well into the future, but also provide for the future generations.
